► About Us

The Office of Behavioral Health (OBH) merges the state's mental health and addiction services into a single, integrated system of care.

OBH services are designed primarily to meet the needs of:

- Individuals — children, youth and adults — and families affected with serious emotional/behavioral issues including co-occurring disorders
- Adolescents and adults with substance use/addictive disorders including gambling, tobacco and opioid use
- Pregnant women and women with dependent children
- People in need of forensic-related mental health treatment

► Direct-Care Services

The Office of Behavioral Health delivers direct care through two state-run inpatient psychiatric hospitals, behavioral health community-based treatment programs, and collaboration with local governing entities (LGEs)/human services districts and

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► Specialty Services

- Prevention, education and awareness of mental and substance use disorders
- Mental health promotion and suicide prevention
- Peer and recovery supports
- Residential substance use disorder services for women and children
- Methadone treatment programs
- Intensive inpatient and outpatient care
- Care coordination for court-ordered youth referrals
- Disaster recovery, including crisis support and counseling services

► Hospital-Based Treatment

- Promotes recovery through the efficient use of evidence-informed care and successful transition to community-based services
- Forensic psychiatric services
- Services for individuals found to be not guilty by reason of insanity and those in need of competency restoration

 - Central Louisiana State Hospital

► Coordinated System of Care

- Collaboration with Louisiana Department of Health, Department of Children and Family Services, Department of Education, Office of Juvenile Justice, Governor's Office and family/youth representatives
- Established for children and youth (ages 5 to 20) who have complex behavioral health needs or co-occurring disorders, and are either in or at risk of out-of-home placement
- Specialized services include:
 - Parent support and training
 - Youth support and training
 - Short-term respite
 - Independent living/skills building
- To access Coordinated System of Care, parents/caregivers or concerned others may contact the child or youth's Medicaid managed care plan for the initial screening process. Learn more at CSoc.la.gov.
